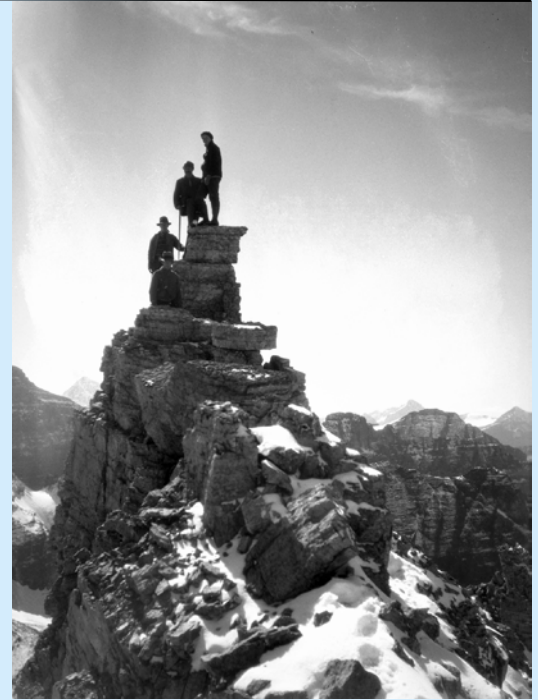
Museum: 10 am- 5 pm daily
